Lodging and M&IE Rate Changes

Effective October 1, 2017, default CONUS (Continental United States) lodging and M&IE rates have been updated by the United States GSA (General Services Administration). As a result, university travel lodging and M&IE rates will be adjusted in accordance with policy.

The standard lodging rate increased from \$91 to \$93. The standard M&IE rate is \$51 (no change). All six tiers for M&IE rates stayed the same for FY18.

The following localities will move to the standard rates for lodging and M&IE:

If you have created Travel Authorizations in the Banner Travel & Expense Management (TEM) system prior to October 1, 2017, for travel that will occur after October 1, 2017, be sure to use the recalculate per diem function in the TEM system when you generate your expense report to obtain the new rates effective October 1, 2017.

BOA Individual Liability Travel Card
